Kick:

Although, Sallu bhai's last release 'Jai Ho' turned out to be quite a shocker and didn't mint enough money at the box office. But Salman Khan and his team including director-producer Sajid Nadiadwala, Jacqueline Fernandez, Randeep Hooda, Mithun Chakraborty and Nawazuddin Siddiqui packed a punch at the cinema screens and managed to cross the Rs 100 crore hurdle.

According to Koimoi, 'Kick' has so far made Rs 126.70 crore in just 5 days. 'Kick' that released just ahead of Eid has already touched the magical figure of Rs 100 crore that is touted to be the litmus test of films these days. While it continue to enjoy a good run at the box office, 'Kick' could not break the record of 'Dhoom 3' that has made the fastest Rs 100 crore so far.

Dhoom 3:

No other film has so far broken this record.
