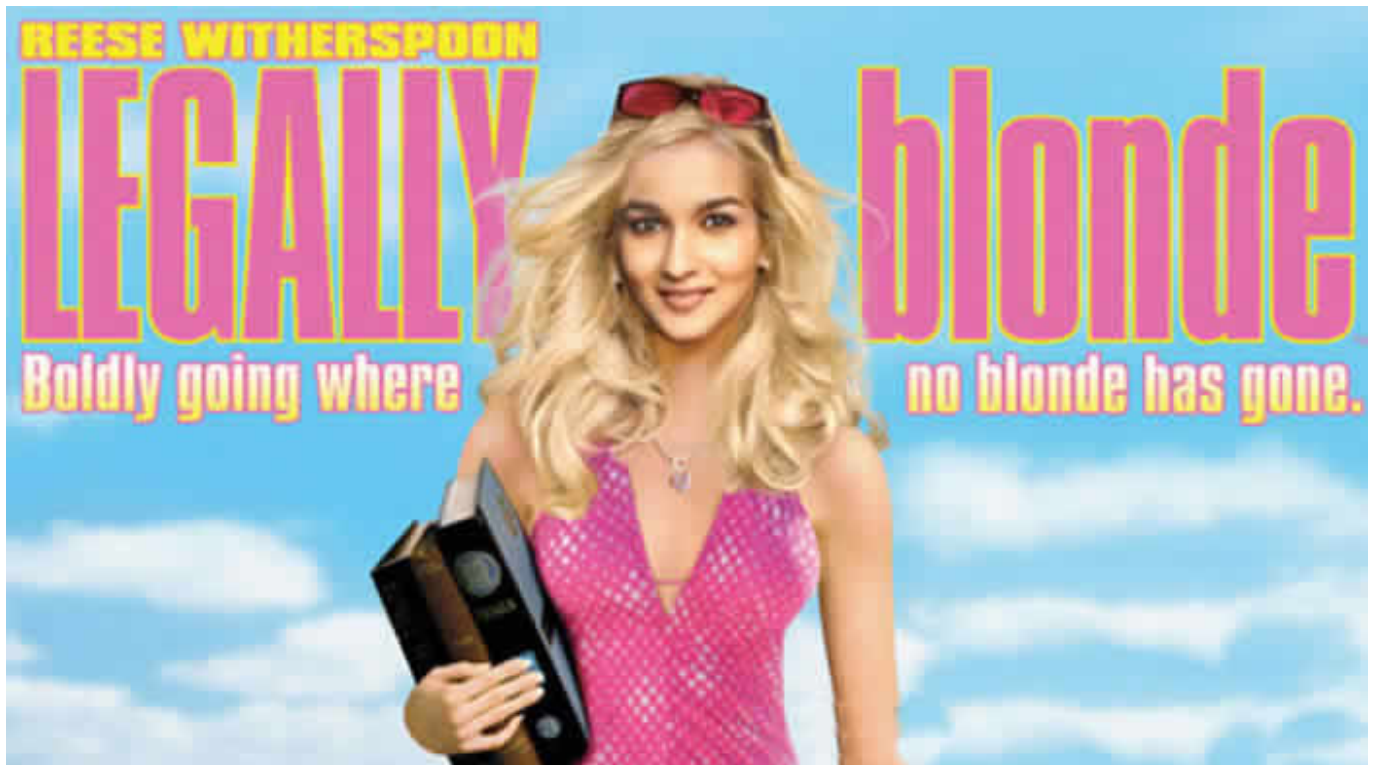


Birthday Special: 7 Things You Know About Alia Bhatt

Legally Blonde



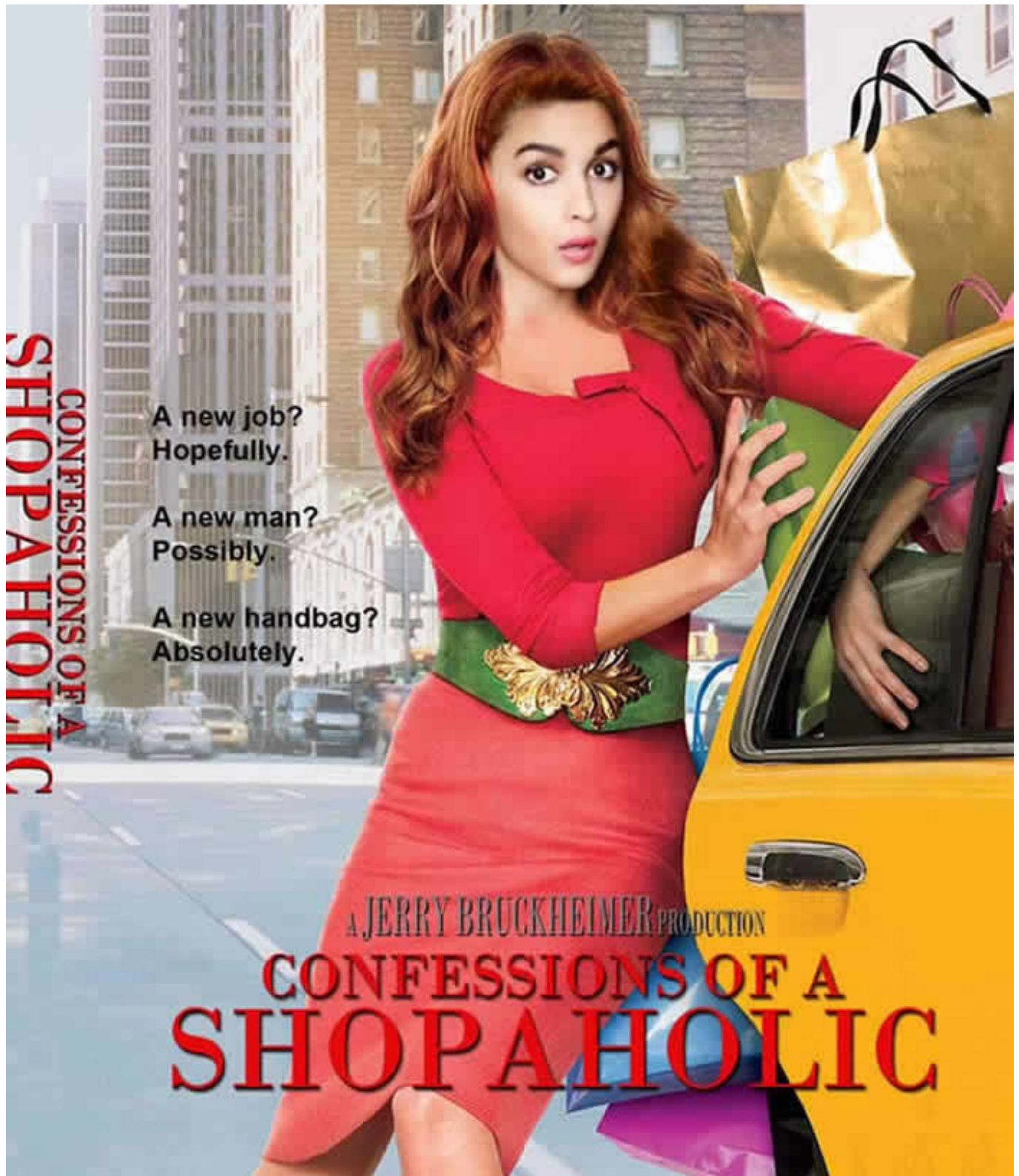
